Jane M Klausman (JMK) Woman in Business Scholarship

(local, district, and International)

The Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships are awarded to women undertaking business studies who have demonstrated outstanding potential in the field. Zonta International offers up to 32 scholarships of US\$5,000 each at the district/region level. Any woman undertaking a business program at an accredited university/college/institute, including online students, in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a Master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club, is eligible to apply. The scholarship may be used at any university, college or institute offering accredited courses and degrees. Application, due August 1

Amelia Earhart Fellowship

(International)

The Amelia Earhart Fellowship is awarded annually to women pursuing Ph.D./doctoral degrees in aerospace-related sciences and aerospace-related engineering. The Fellowship of US\$10,000, awarded to 30 Fellows around the globe each year, may be used at any university or college offering accredited post-graduate courses and degrees in these fields.

Application will open in July 2023.

On Saturday, April 1, 2023, Zonta Club of Lafayette members assembled 54 BELOVED BUNDLES bags for our S.A.N.E. nurses to present to survivors of sexual assault. When a survivor goes to the hospital to have a forensic exam by a S.A.N.E. (Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner), often called a "rape kit," and law enforcement is involved, many times their belongings are seized as evidence. Survivors are left with nothing to wear home from the hospital. A Beloved Bundle includes: clothing, undergarments, hygiene products and other necessary items so that the survivor can leave with dignity and know that someone cares.
